Demographic Key Points

Population Characteristics

Younger than the County as whole, the median age is 32.7 compared to Sullivan's 42.3. 31.4% of the population are children under the age of 18.

2,176 housing units in Liberty

1070 renter units

29.8% home ownership rate in Liberty

69.2% home ownership rate in Sullivan County

Vacant Properties

20.1% of Liberty Village's housing stock was vacant with 114 units reserved for seasonal use and 199 units listed as "Other vacant," which indicates they are off the market due to reasons such as abandonment or being held in probate.

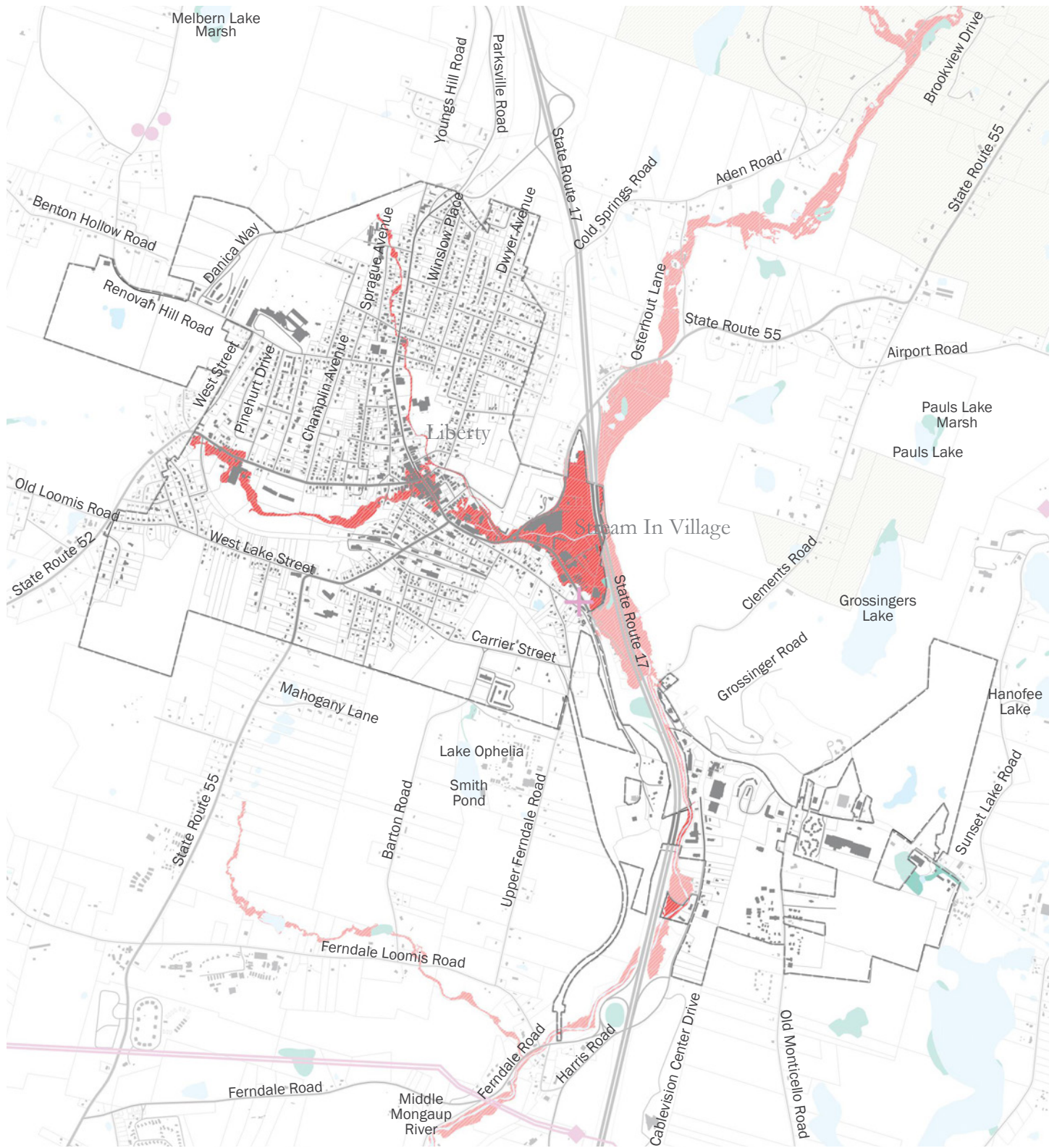

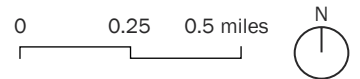

- The Liberty Village Creek area experiences severe flooding




